§ 1 Scope

This user agreement applies to the online learning platform "StudOn", provided by the Friedrich-Alexander-University Erlangen-Nuremberg (in the following "operator").

§ 2 Subject Matter

1. StudOn is an integrated, online learning and working environment that is used by all facilities of the University.
2. StudOn provides web-based learning material, different objects for organizational matters and means of communication which are reserved for personal use as part of university education only.
3. The Institute for Learning Innovation (ILI), located at the University of Erlangen-Nuremberg, is responsible for conceptional and operational aspects (regarding content and technical matters) as well as for the project management of StudOn as a whole. StudOn is hosted by the Regional Computer Centre Erlangen.

§ 3 Target group

1. The use of StudOn is reserved for those who are affiliated to the University Erlangen-Nuremberg.
